

FAYETTEVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT 2014 Annual Traffic Report

The Fayetteville Police Department is committed to assisting the citizens of Fayetteville in traveling its roadways in a safe and efficient manner. Although the total number of traffic violations cited was down in 2014, the department documented a minimal increase in the number of motor vehicle collisions. Statistics regarding motor vehicle collision and various traffic violations are noted in the below chart.
