I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to formulate a procedure of working with other law enforcement and social welfare agencies.

The Fayetteville Police Department shall strive to hold annual meetings with representatives from the Fayetteville Fire Department to promote better coordination between the two departments.

II. POLICY

A. LIAISON

3. Public and Social Service Agencies

1. Other Agency Liaison

The Fayetteville Police Department shall provide officers with a list of social services at the state and local levels and other resources available to the public.

It shall be the policy of the Fayetteville Police Department to establish and maintain a working liaison with the following organization;

B. INTERAGENCY COORDINATION AND PLANNING

a. Other law enforcement agencies (particularly in northwest Arkansas);

1. Criminal Justice Coordinating Council

b. Members of the judicial process at the federal, state, and local levels; and

It shall be the policy of the Fayetteville Police Department to support local and state efforts to collectively plan criminal justice activities by providing a representative, when possible.

c. Representatives of the state probation and parole system.

2. Fire Department Liaison

2. Liaison with Traffic Safety Agencies

It shall be the policy of the Fayetteville Police Department to maintain a positive ongoing relationship with local, state, and federal agencies responsible for monitoring traffic safety and public education.

3. Requests for Assistance

When another agency requests assistance, the senior supervisor on duty will receive the request and will determine if aid can, and should be rendered. The supervisor will then assign police personnel and equipment with instructions or cause the field supervisor to do so if the patrol program is involved. All Fayetteville police personnel will follow department rules, regulations and policy while on special assignments.
