Techstars Startup Weekend is the place to build a team, create a prototype of the idea, validate the business idea, and receive feedback from experienced entrepreneurs, all in one weekend. Eleven teams were formed over the weekend, and first-place was won by modular robotics kit ModBot.





The Nowehere Developer's Conference, a one-day technology conference for software developers and engineers was held here in NWA. The goal of the event was to provide a platform for industry professionals to engage and collaborate.
